Create a poster all about the significant (important) people in your life.


Revise the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Can you make a song or rhyme to help you remember them?

Create a fact file all about Mary Seacole. Why was she? What sort of life did she have? Why is she considered significant?

Write a newspaper report about Rosa Parks and her demonstration on the bus. What might have happened? Who saw? What did they have to say?


Draw yourself as a superhero. Label the significant parts of yourself, including 3 special superpowers.

Use standard (cm's) and non-standard (objects) units of measure to measure objects around your home. Can you display your findings in an interesting way.



Write a diary entry as Gandhi. What is happening in your life? What do you think is important and why?

Design a poster or presentation about the life of Mother Teresa. Why is she significant? What events have happened in her lifetime?



Create a comic book or story showing yourself as a super hero with super powers. What adventures will you get up to?

Create a maths quiz about everything you have learned this year so far. Make sure you include an answer sheet. Test your parents and friends.

Create a protest sign for or against something you have a strong belief in. More play time? More time on the x-box? Less school?

Create a piece of art work about one of our 4 significant people. Try too use materials other than pencils and pens.
